- Tritex site still an issue both MP's for Leicestershire are currently working with Ministers on its future
- Block C could potentially be an issue for the Borough Council is Cineworld pull out
- Rhodes Lane cars have been skidding into the hedge on the S bend, Signs still require attention, Manhole has been repaired
- Raised concerns with the MP Dr Luke Evans regarding the huge increase in Water bills from Severn Trent

- Warned the members of Car Jacking in the area as a lady was chased from Bosworth to Barwell. Police were called but after waiting an hour and a half no Police attended. Official complaint has been raised. Advised to keep doors locked when travelling
