2. The Chairman gave a verbal report to the meeting as follows
 - Gave thanks to his predecessor for his work last year
 - Looking forward to transforming Barwell into a greener village
 - Working closely with both County and Borough Council to improve recycling
 - Giving support to the Community House and look at getting our library back
 - More use of the Jubilee Hall possibly with a play group
 - Raising revenue for the repair of the Cemetery Chapels eaves by using the Chapels more
 - Tidy Up Top Town by removing dead tree and better litter bins

- Liaising with Borough Council regarding Top Range Motors eyesore
 - Bringing local charities and businesses together by way of open forums
3. County Councillor Mr B Crooks gave a verbal report as follows
- Recycling Centre closing for 3 weeks for maintenance
 - There are 550 children currently in care
 - Campaign to try and save rural transport
4. A verbal report was received from Borough Councillor Mr H Williams

- Borough Council has been left with a decent budget
 - Issue on the Cinema Block
 - Successful outcome on the Gladman Appeal costing the Borough Council £43K to win
 - Grants awarded for Barwell Parks and Footpath refurbishment
 - 4 years' work on Top Range Motors to continue by the Borough Council
 - Newlands School successful transfer to the newly refurbished site on Bell Vue Road
 - Concerns about the lack of Police in Barwell
